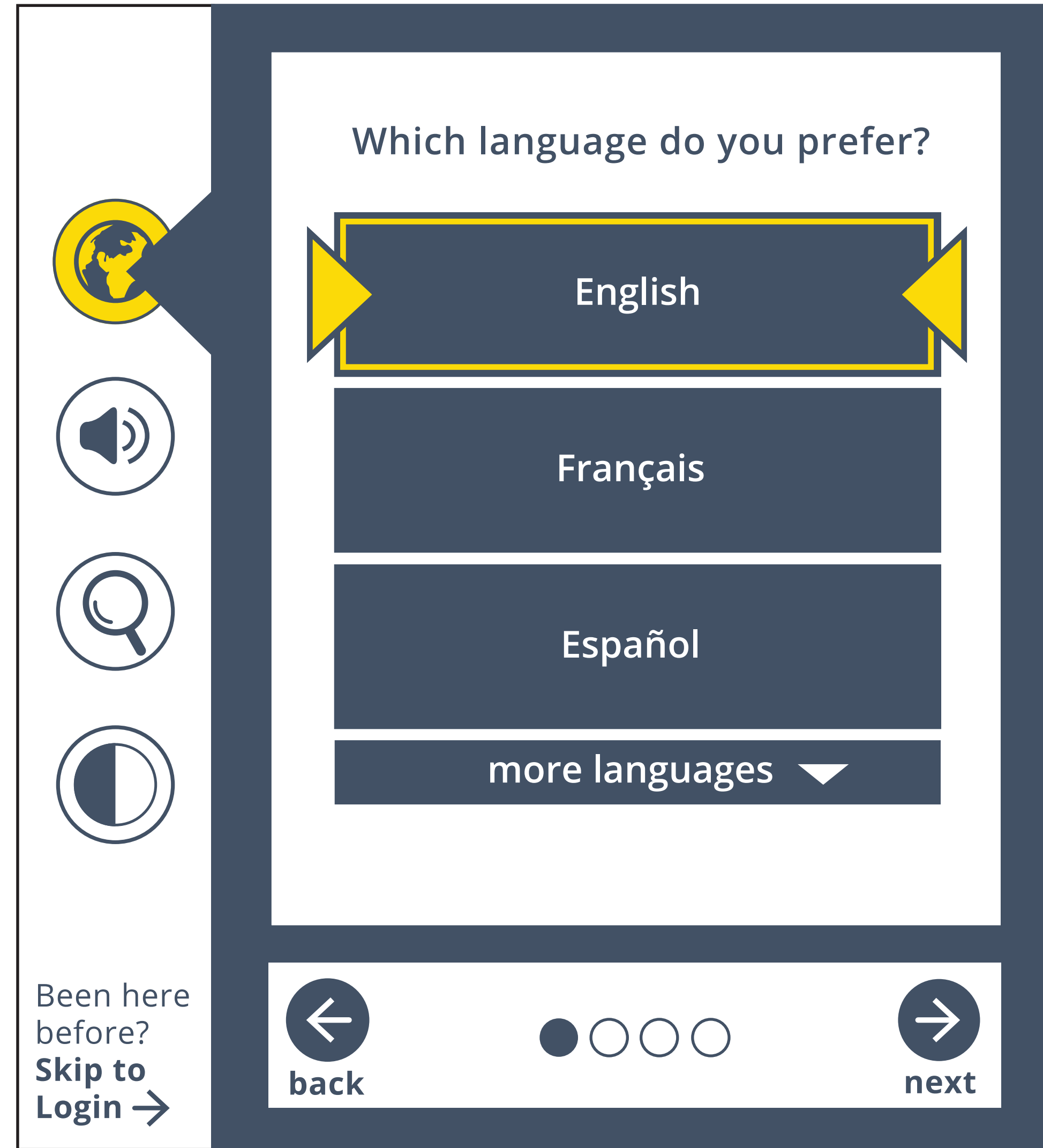


Language screen appears first
Visual and audio focus could cycle through the options until selection is made
Current selection is show with triangular arrows, yellow box follows keyboard focus



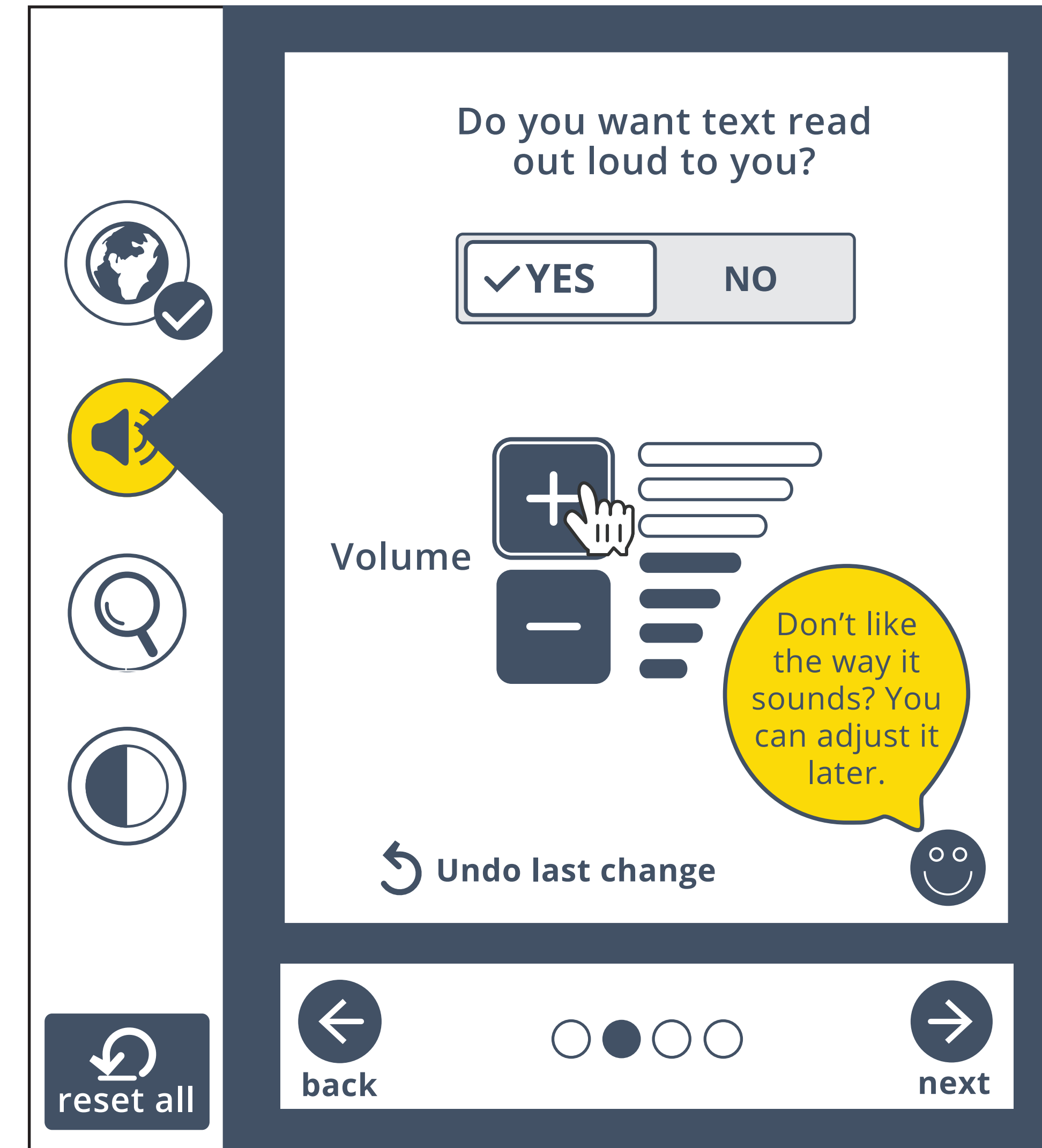
Prompt question also changes language as focus changes?



Once a selection is made, all text changes to selected language, except for the Undo text which remains in previous language until user goes to next screen

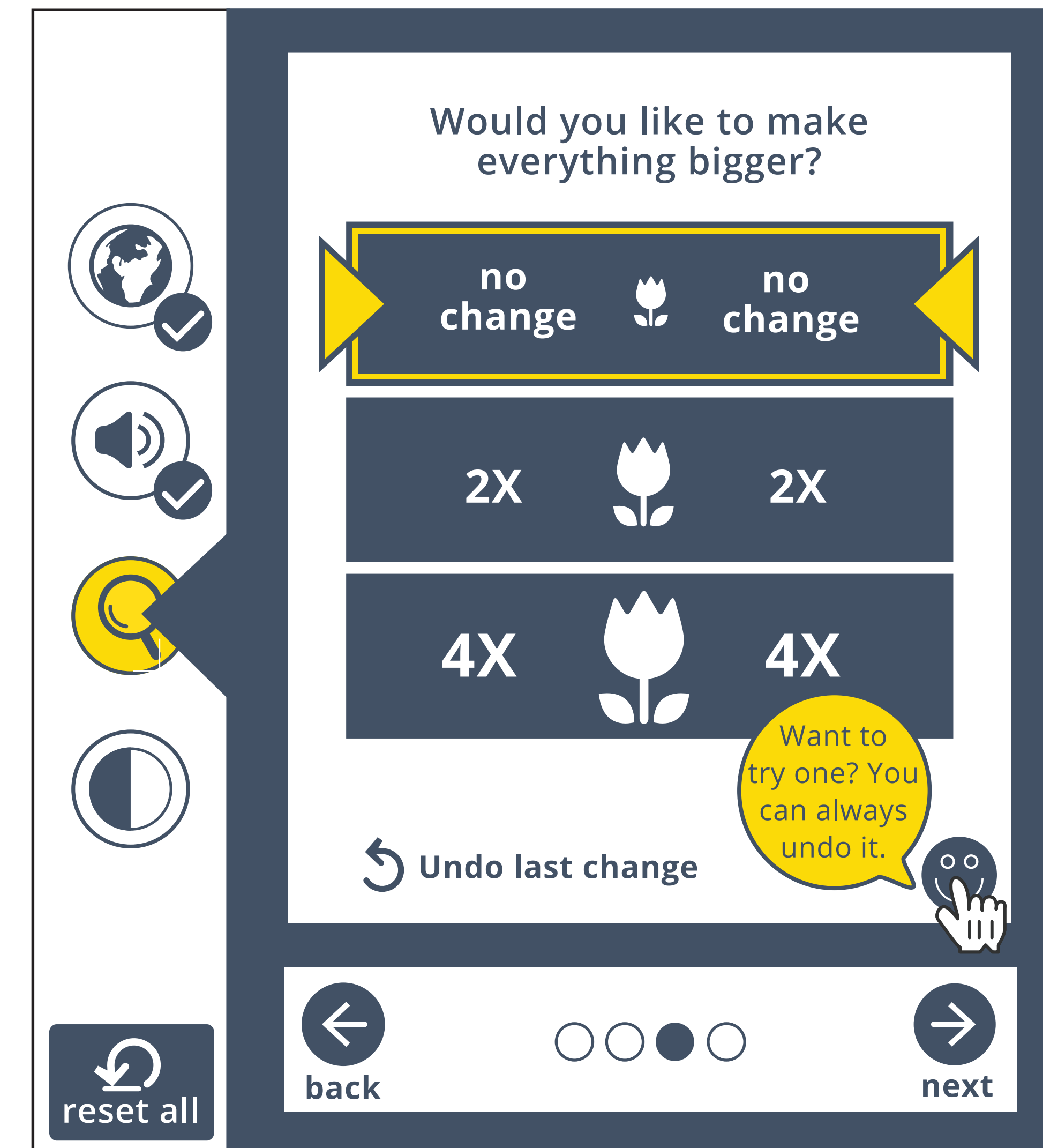


Screen reader screen



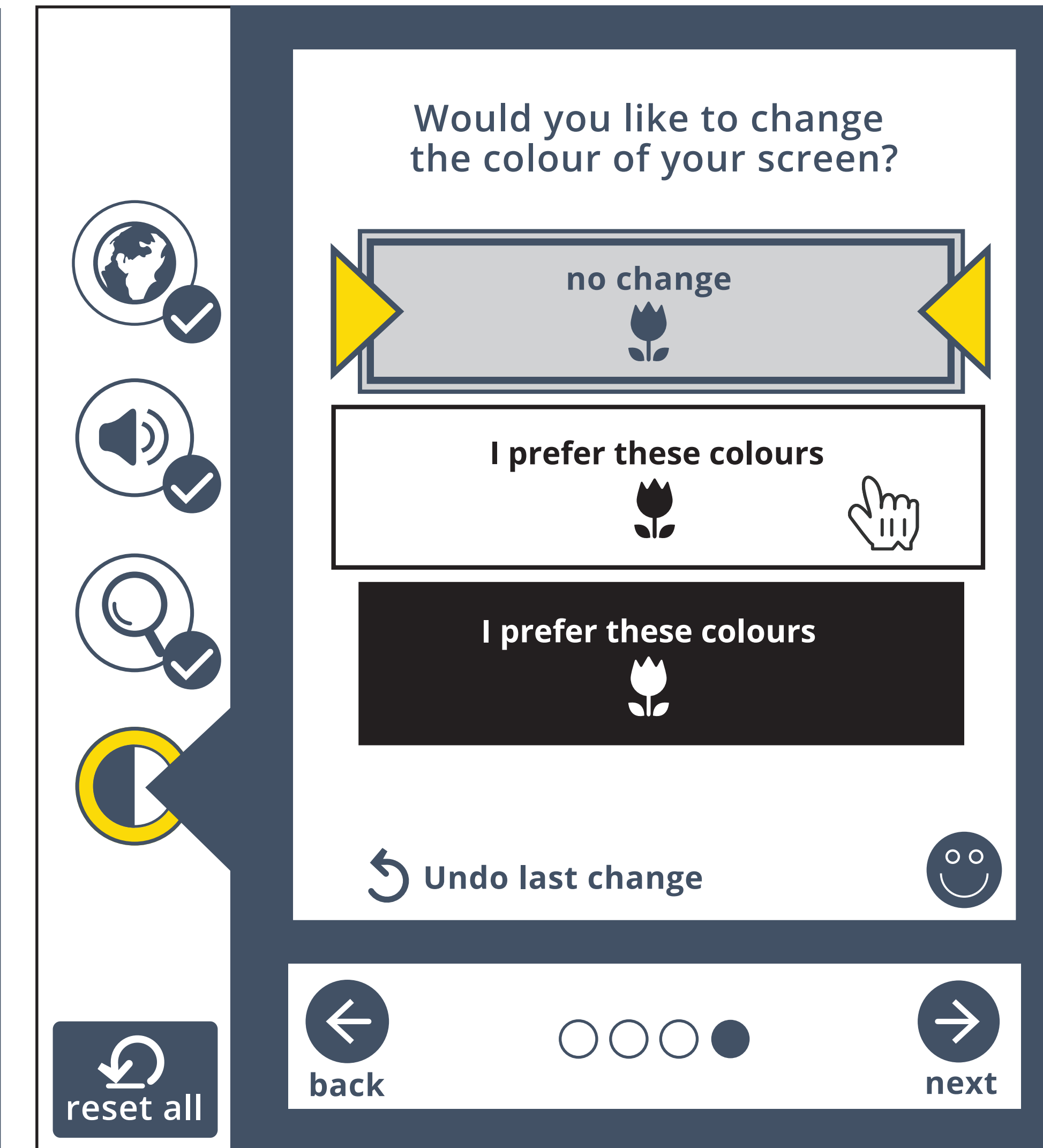
occasional prompts appear?
"don't like the way it sounds..." to let user know refinements can be made later
prompt appears when user hovers over or selects happy face?

Magnifier screen



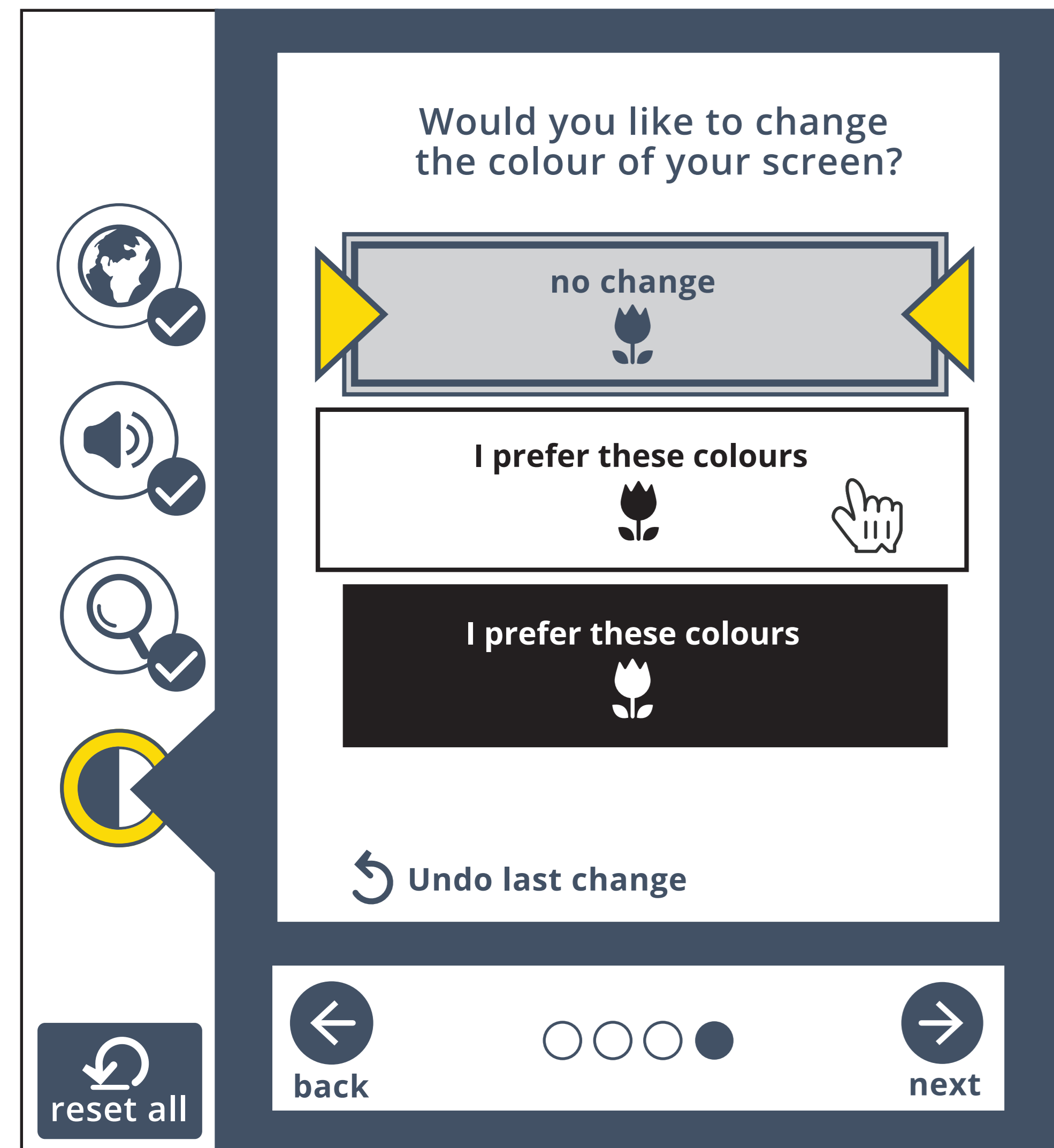
prompts can also encourage user to try something out

Colour/contrast - showing current selection (no change) and hover state (black on white)



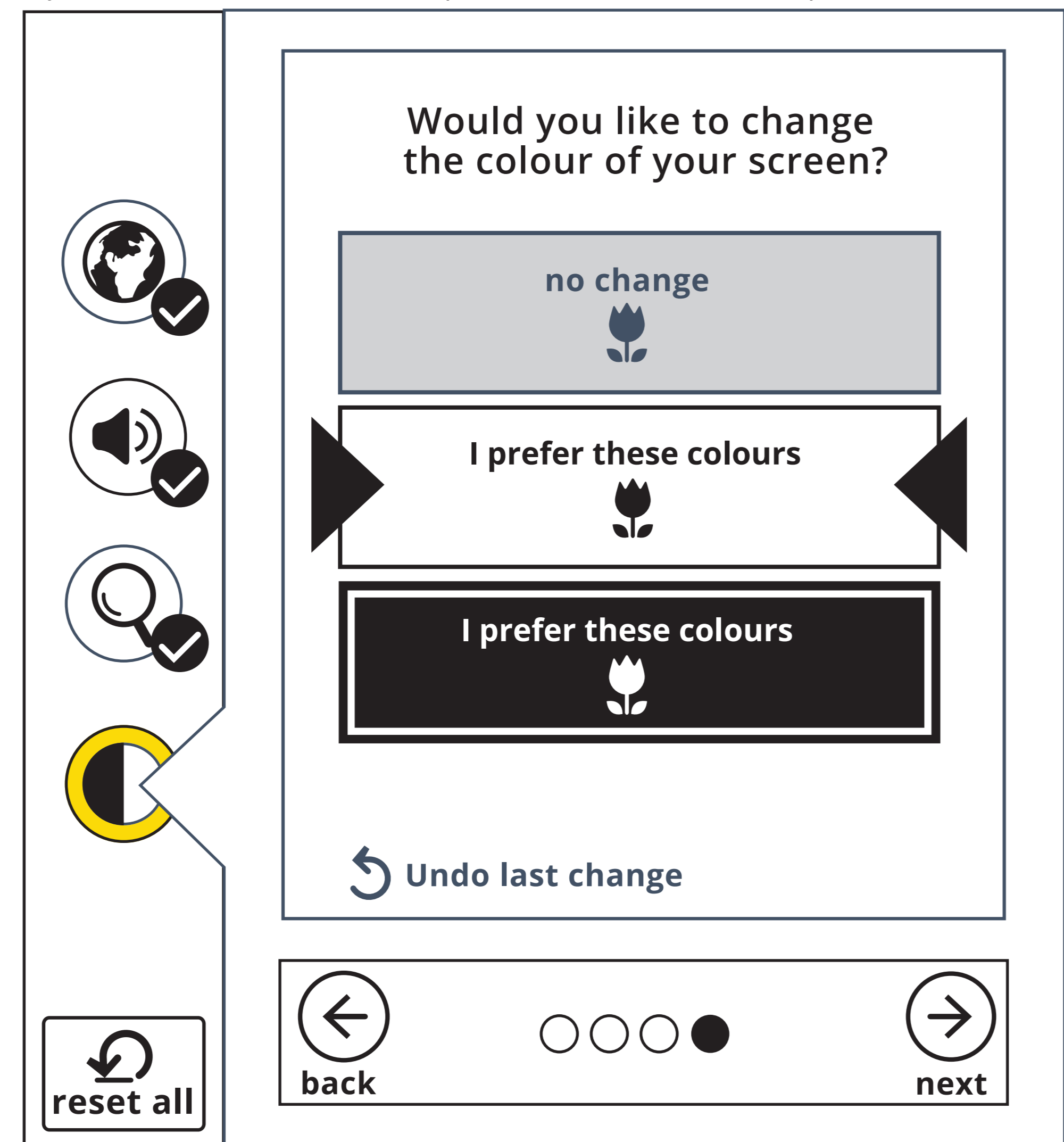
Example of tool responding to user's selection - colour/contrast

Default selection = no change

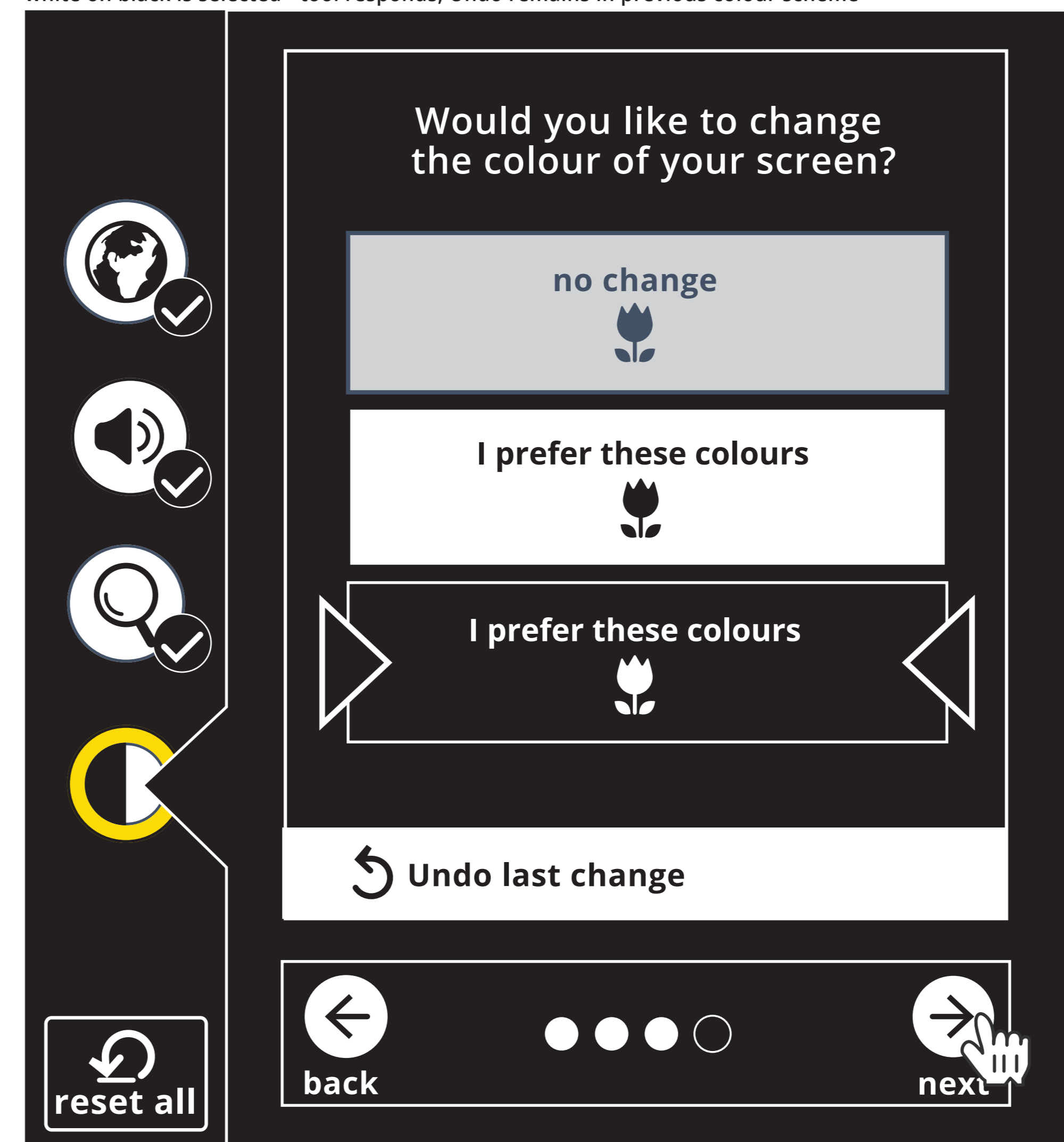


Black on white has been selected.

Keyboard focus moves to white on black option (Undo icon and text remain in previous colour scheme).



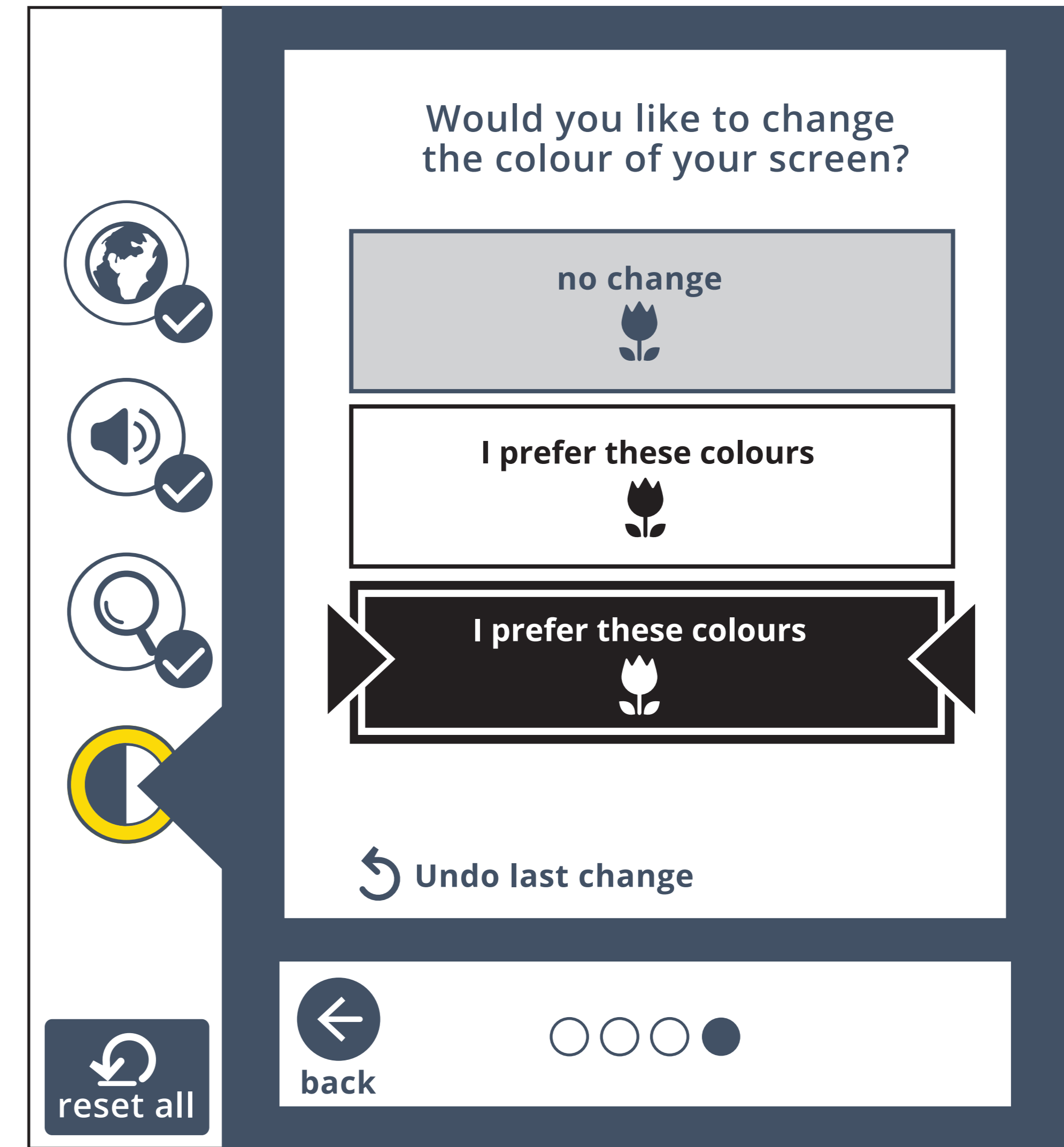
white on black is selected - tool responds, Undo remains in previous colour scheme



Alternatively, sample content could be revealed in a preview window, and Confirm button appears within the preview window in same colour scheme

Confirming would apply the change everywhere and take the user to the following screen

This ensures that the user can interact with the transformed content before proceeding

These screens could be part of the refinement of preferences (post-first-discovery)
e.g. selecting "keyboard only" could prompt preference suggestions such as Sticky Keys or Mouse Keys
"I don't use a keyboard" could take user to on-screen keyboard options or other
