This project will work to provide tools to self-advocates, families, professionals, and policymakers working to support the rights of all people with intellectual and developmental disabilities to community living and participation. In collaboration with the Taishoff Center for Inclusive Higher Education, the University of Delaware, and the Self-Advocacy Association of New York State (SANYS), this project will create free digital resources promoting community living and participation among people with intellectual disabilities in the United States.
