1 Default “Always allow all services” (shown here with two exceptions, added by the user)

2 When “Only allow...” radio button is selected, the drop-down opens (or when user selects drop-down, “Only allow...” radio button is selected).  
>If no app is selected from the list, the radio button automatically returns to “Always allow...”  
>pservices already in the list will not appear in drop-down

Exceptions listed under “Always allow...” remain until deleted

3 Selected service gets added to “Only allow...” list

4 Services can be deleted

5 If all services under “Only allow...” get deleted, radio button is returned to “Always allow all services”

6 All services deleted from exceptions list
