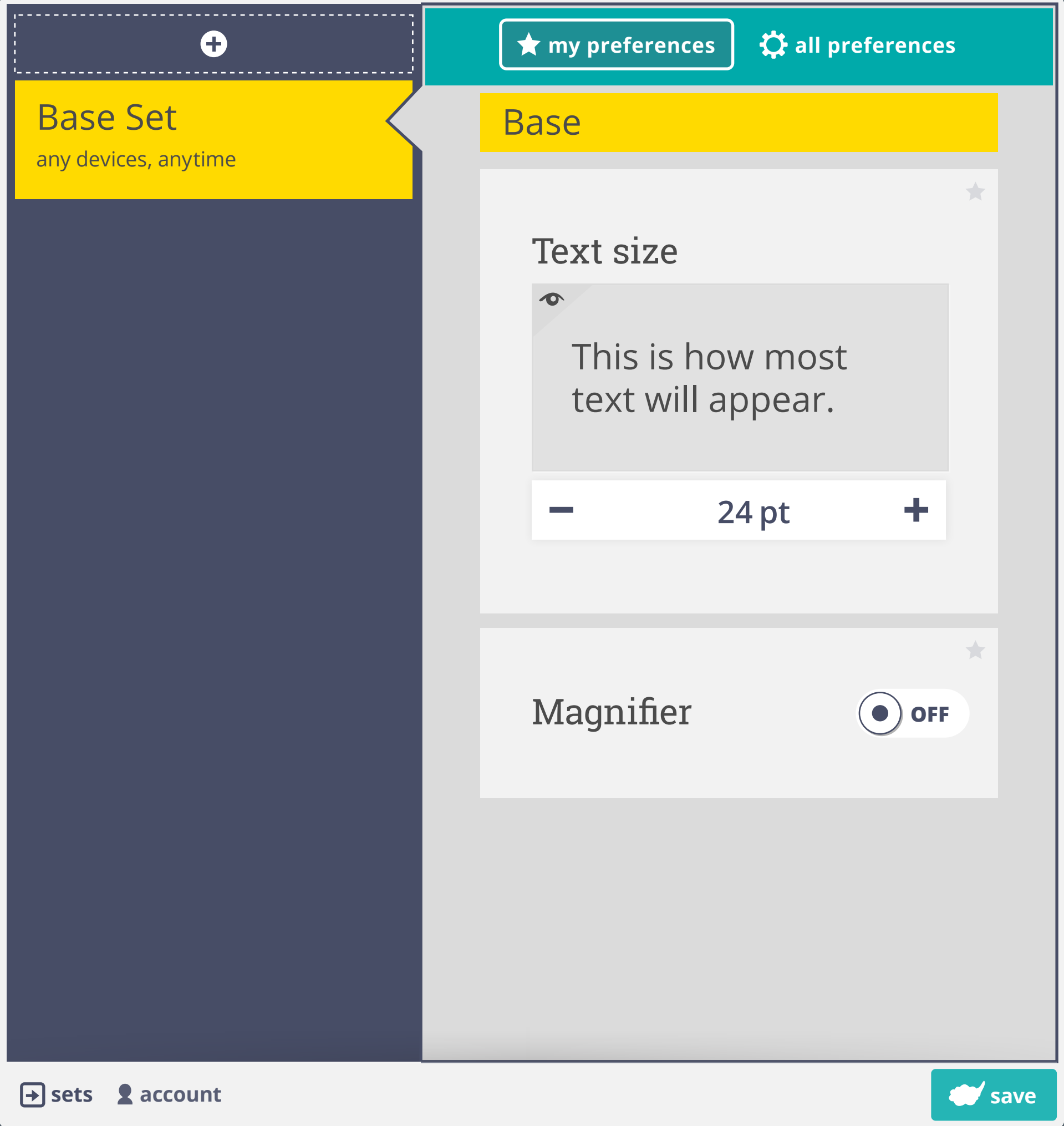
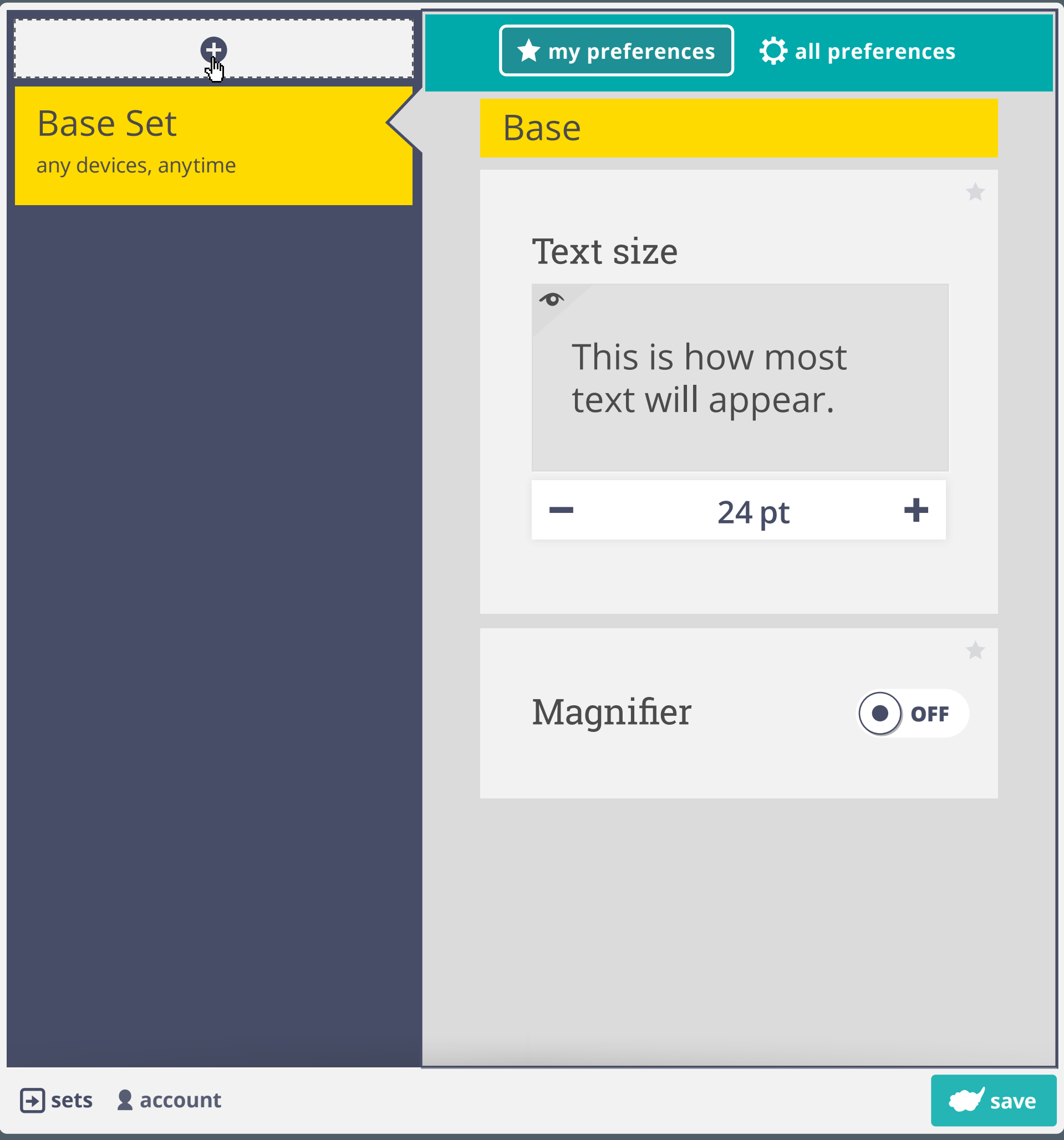


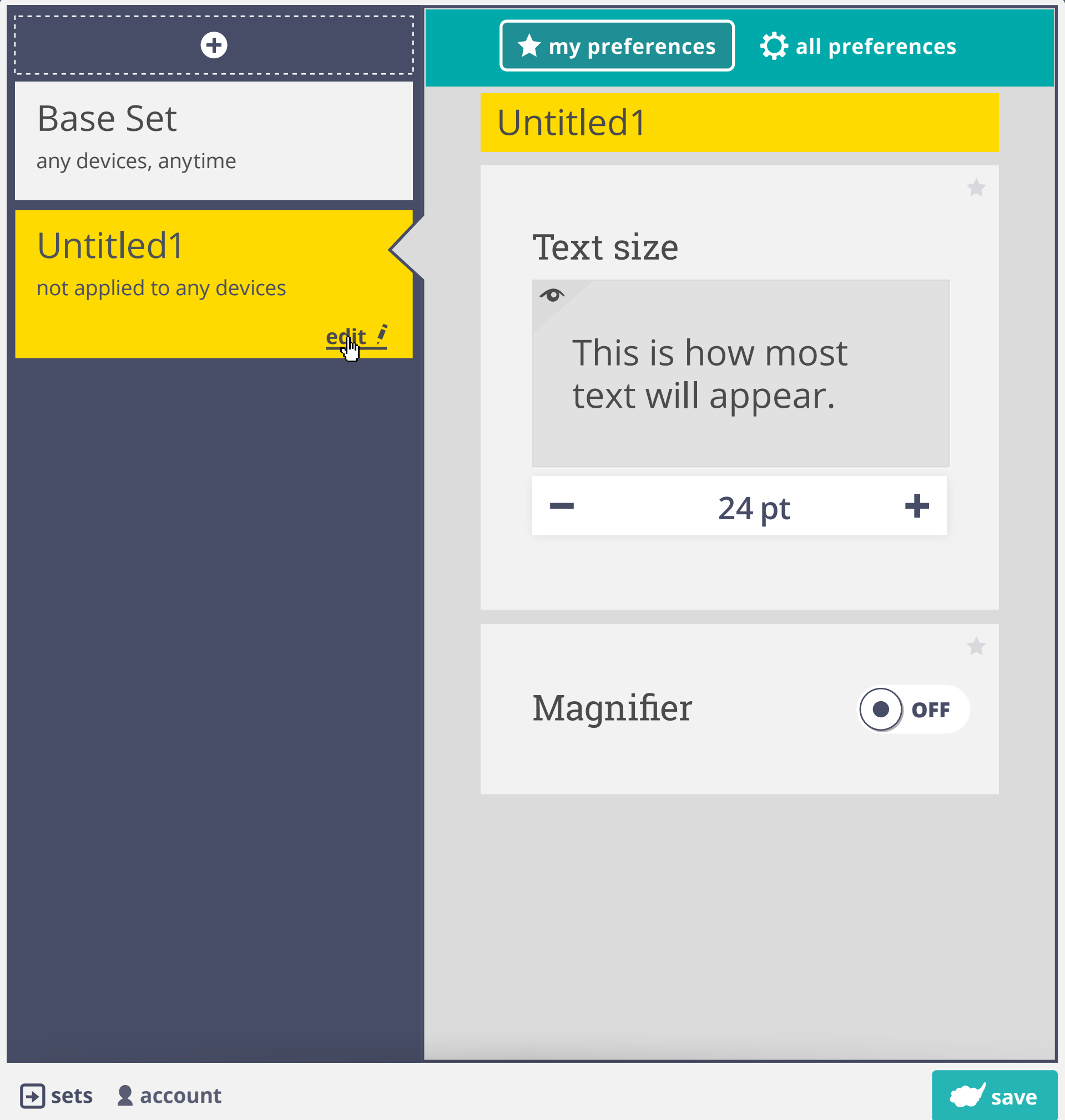
PMT view showing sets panel in expanded state.
Highlighted set has preferences revealed



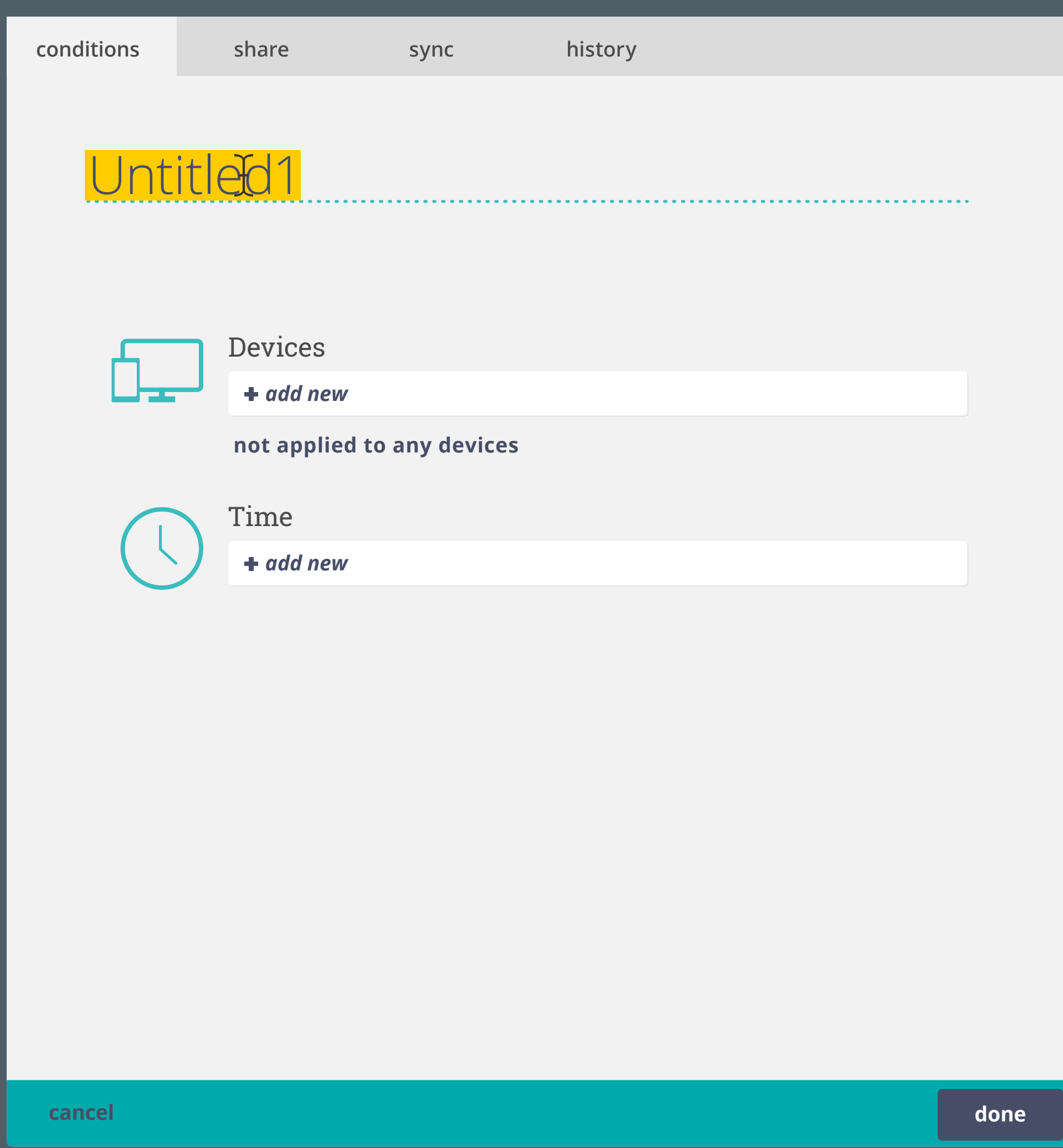
add new set by selecting "+" sign (hover state shown)



New set appears in list with "not applied to any devices"
>new set is populated with base set prefs until user adjusts /removes/adds preferences



Set name is editable



‘Conditions’ tab allows user to manually adjust the contexts a set gets applied in

Conditions are editable in all sets except the ‘Base Set’

> the ‘Base Set’ is applied on all devices, at all times, unless overridden by a conditional set

When a set is first created, it has no contexts and it is not applied to any device

Once a condition is set, it will apply to all devices during that context unless a device is specified

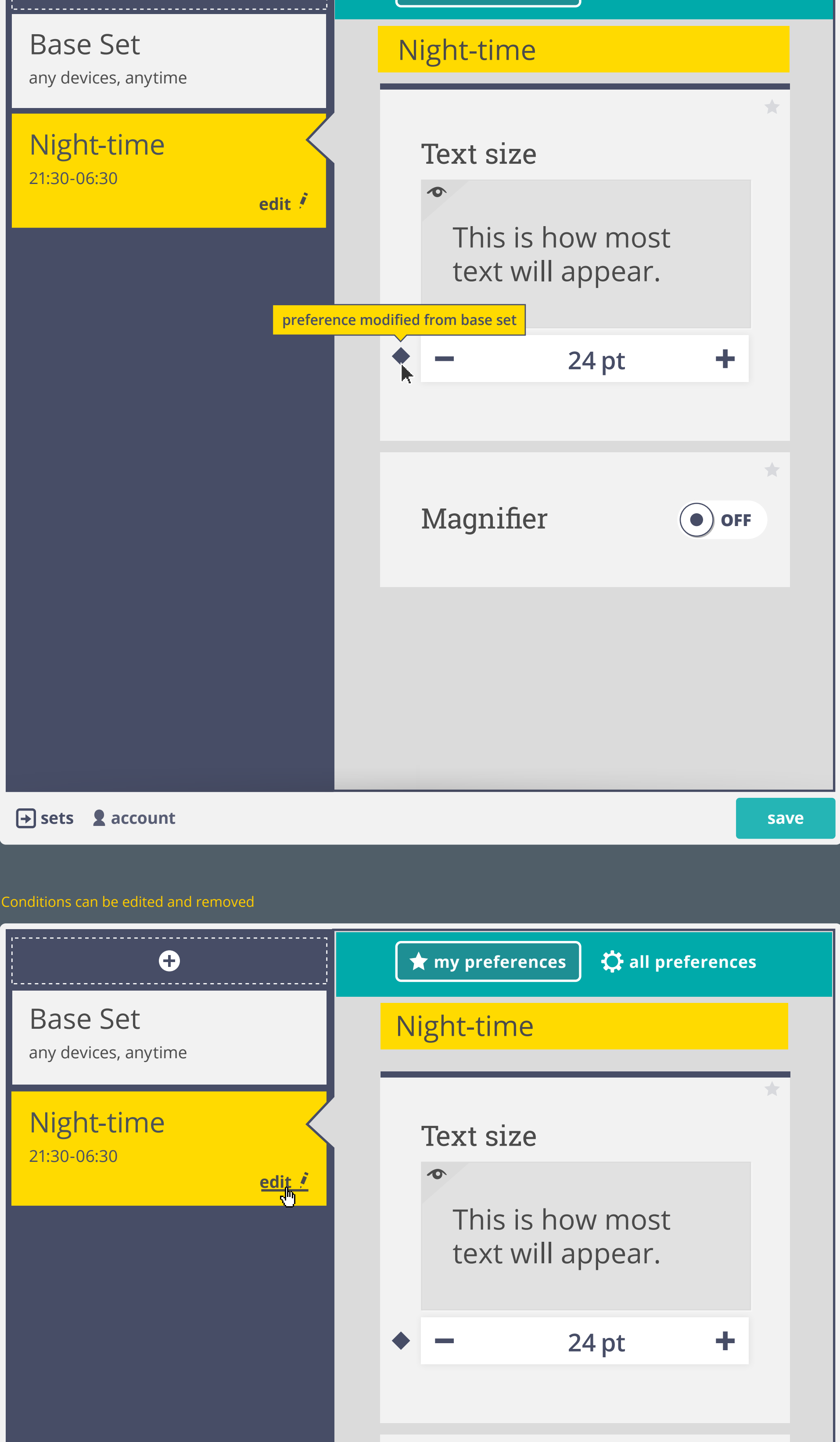

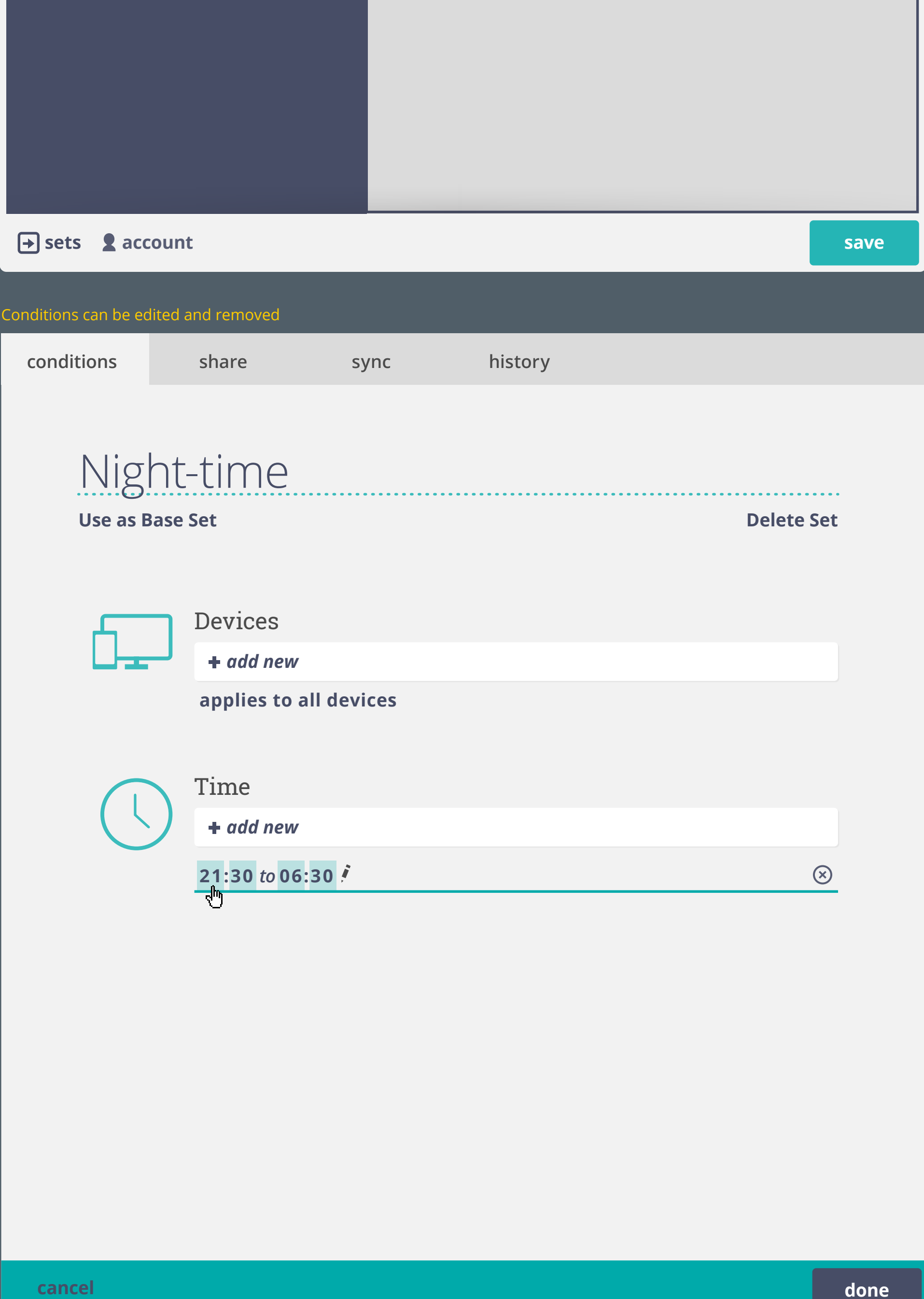

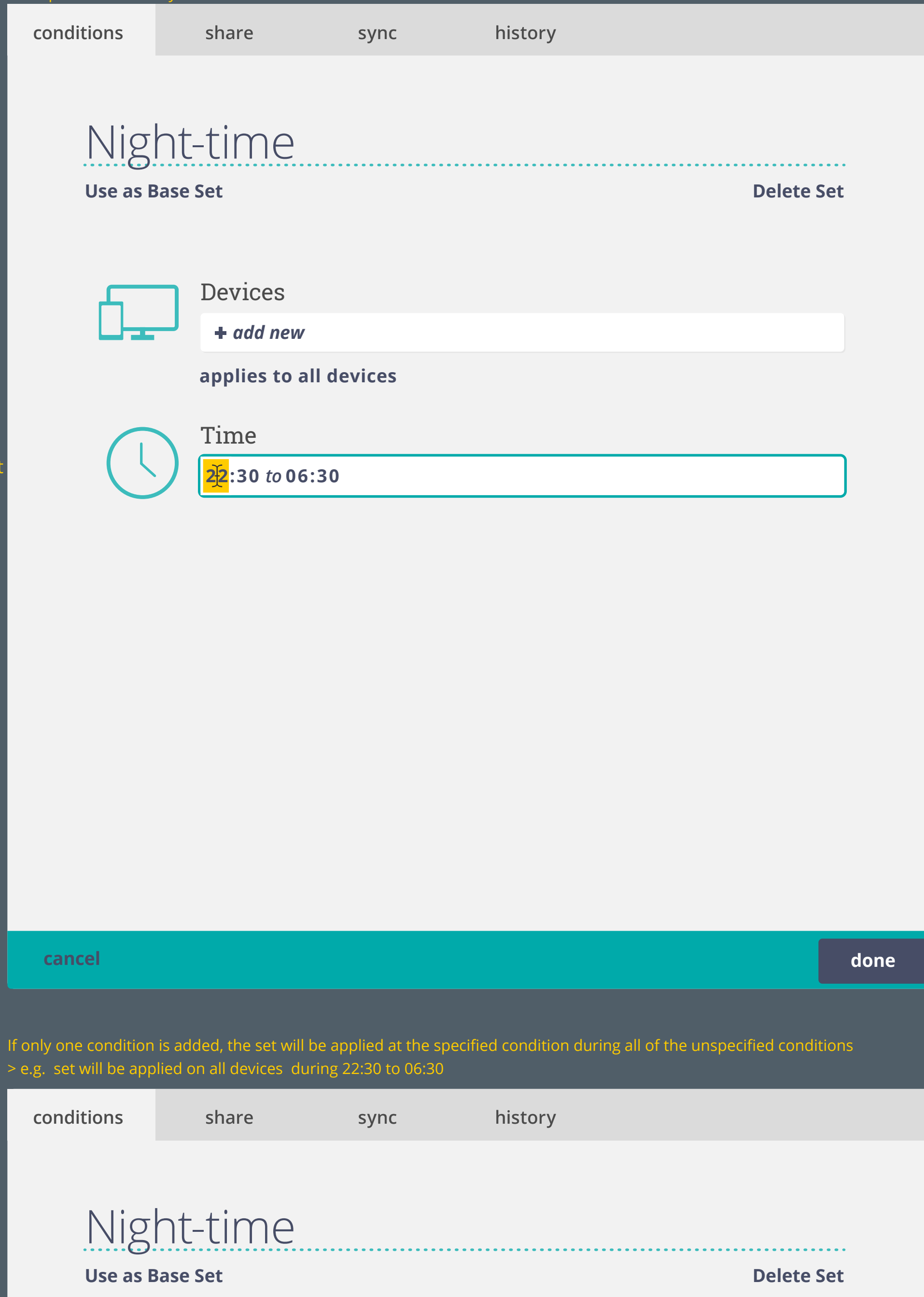
PMT general view
Selecting a set (select set name / box) brings up the 'my preferences' of that set. Edit option appears once selected.
Indicators (dark blue line and diamond beside adjuster) show which preferences have been modified from the 'Base set'



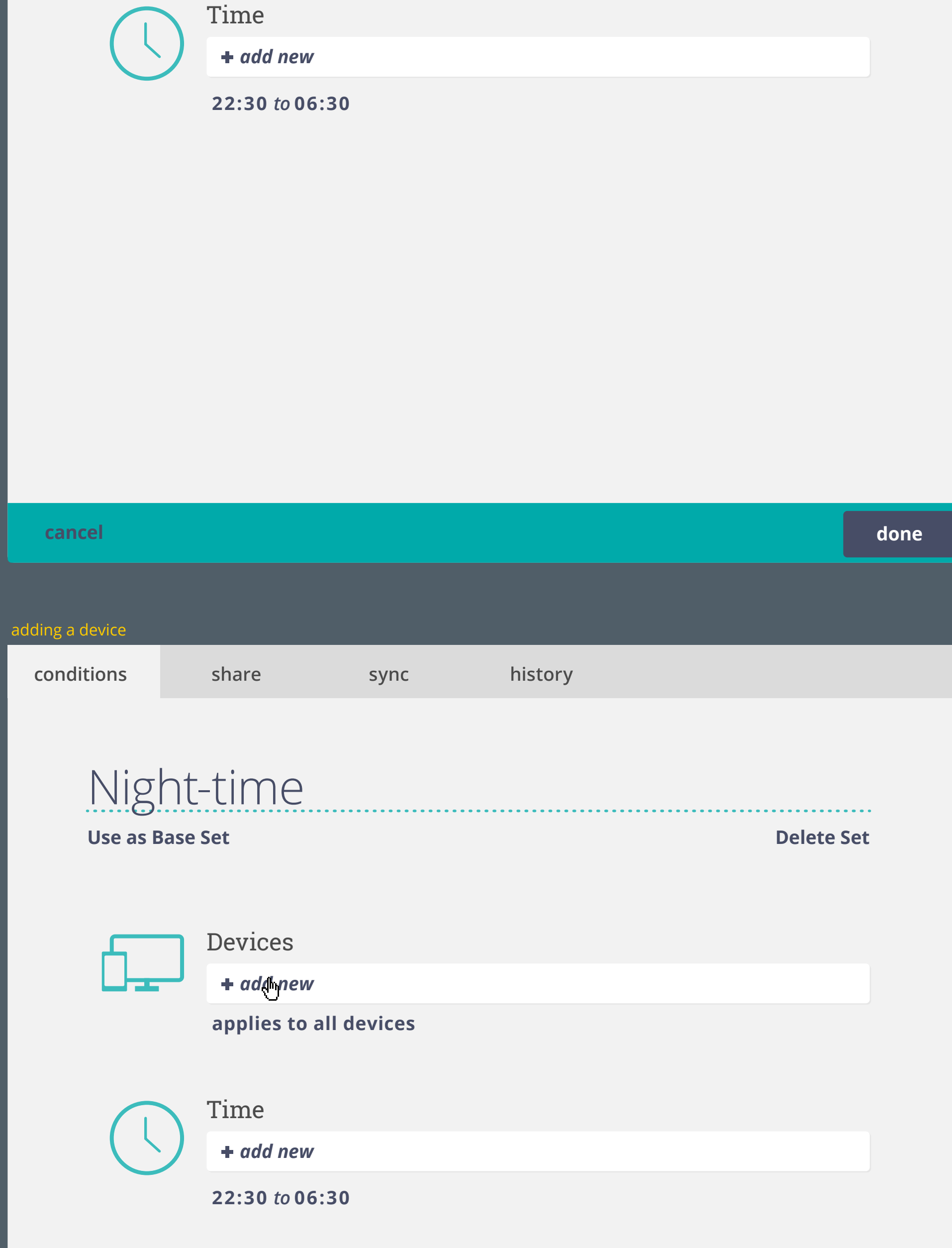
Conditions can be edited and removed



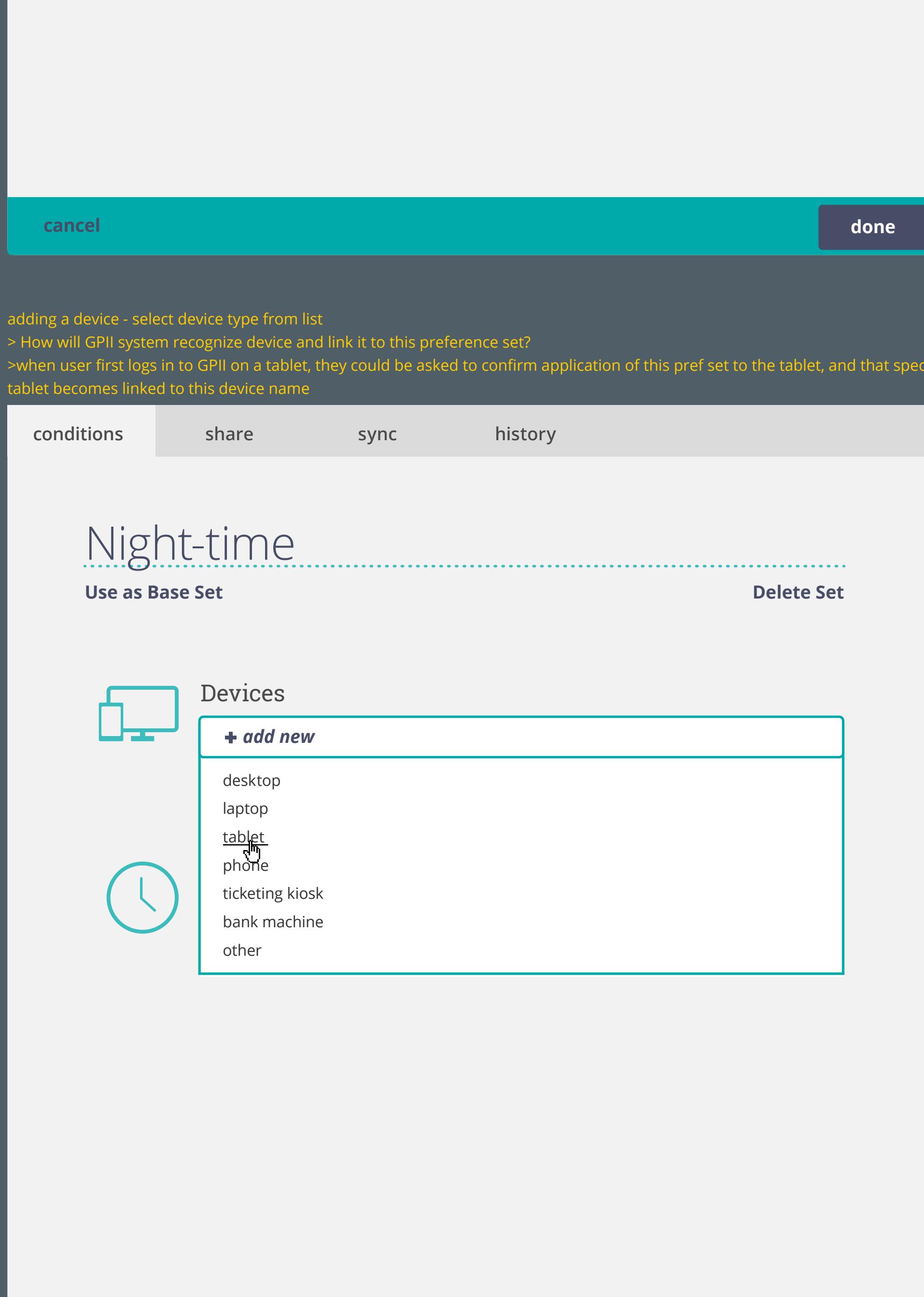
Editing Time context
> Individual number fields are text-editable or adjusted using arrow keys
> Mouse-clicking outside of edit field, tabbing out of edit field, or selecting enter will enter edited values
> escape to cancel entry



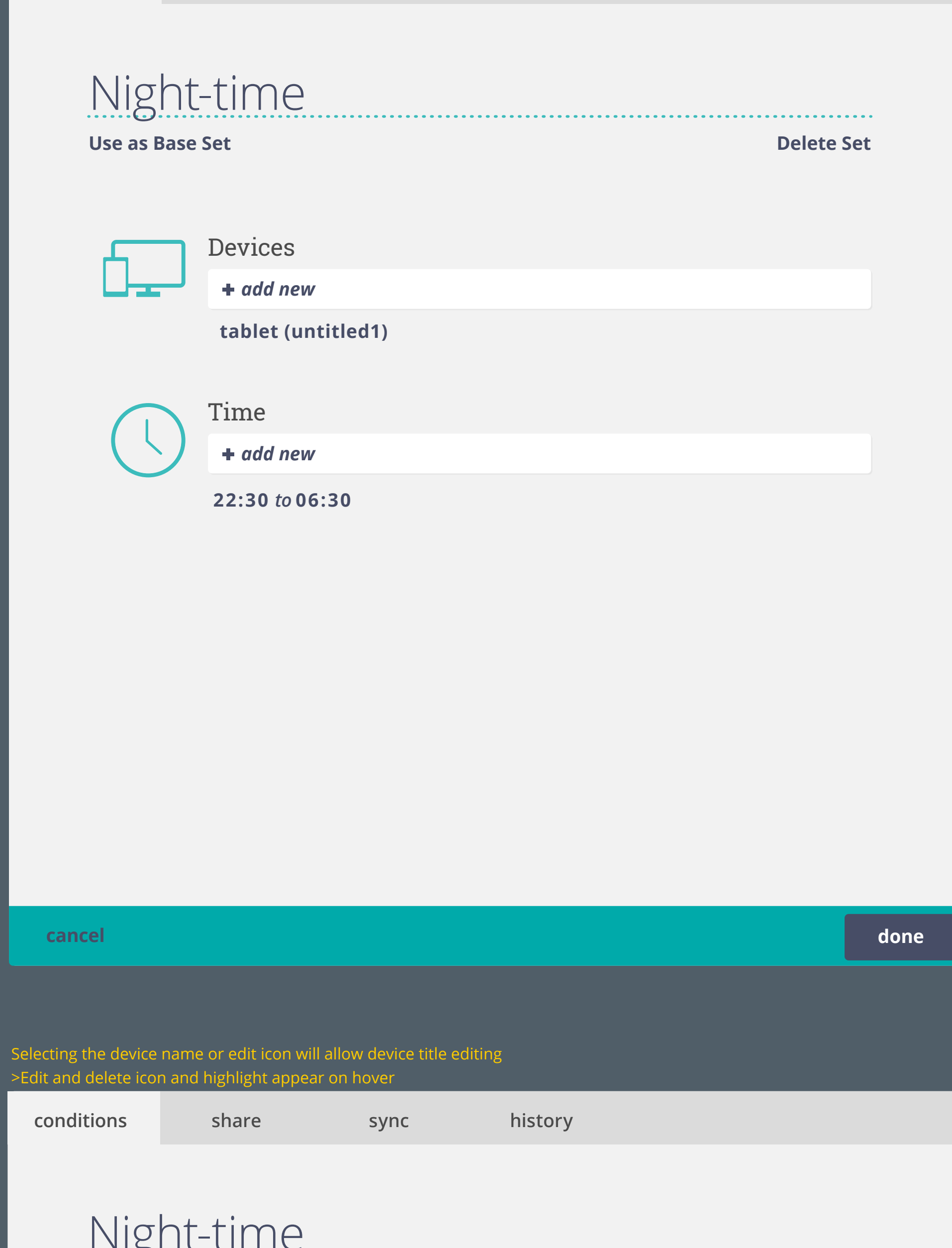
If only one condition is added, the set will be applied at the specified condition during all of the unspecified conditions
> e.g. set will be applied on all devices during 22:30 to 06:30



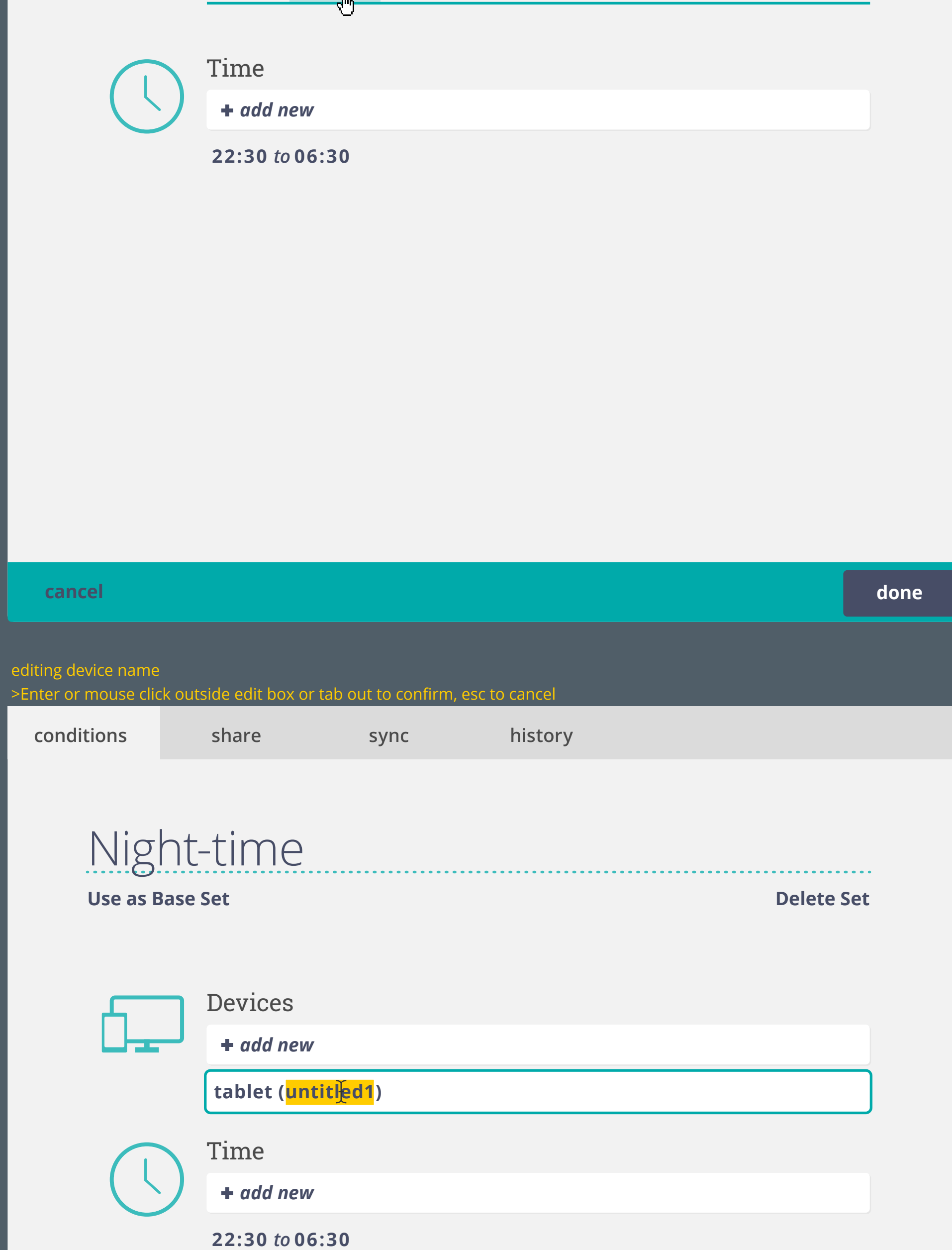
adding a device



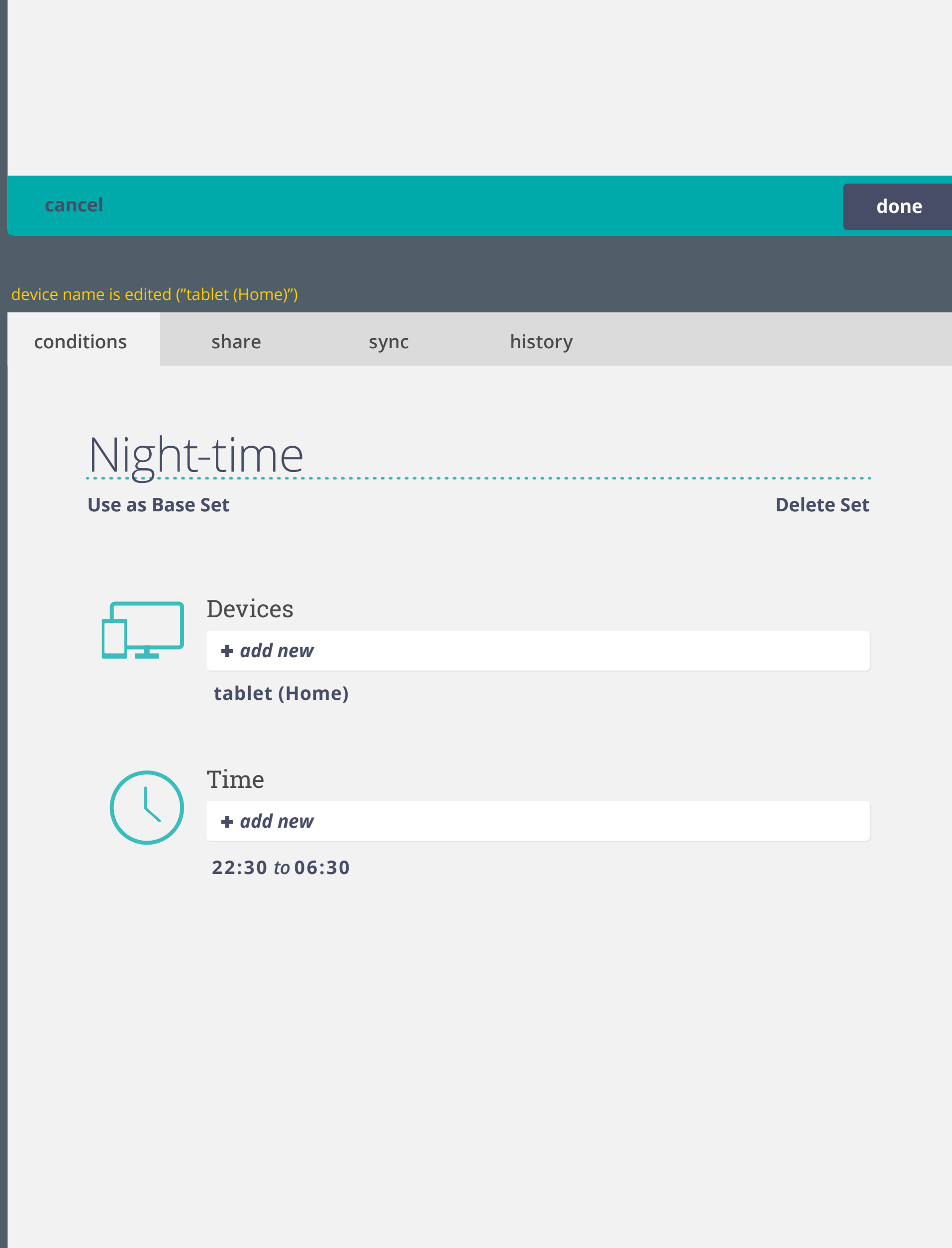
adding a device - select device type from list
> How will GPII system recognize device and link it to this preference set?
> when user first logs in to GPII on a tablet, they could be asked to confirm application of this pref set to the tablet, and that specific tablet becomes linked to this device name



Selecting the device name or edit icon will allow device title editing
> Edit and delete icon and highlight appear on hover



editing device name
> Enter or mouse click outside edit box or tab out to confirm, esc to cancel



new device and updated time are added to the conditions listed under set name
