

Visiting Students Perspective (part 2)




They select a tour that best matches the 19th Century topic, and then press print



David reaches down to the opening in the kiosk to retrieve the 8.5 X 11 colour tour map that tells them exactly where to go.




Jeff holds the map out to the rest of the team and the boys locate the kiosk icon and start to orientate themselves to the north and south direction.
